

Worship Policy (including French principle of "laicity")

CFBL is a non-faith school which welcomes pupils from a variety of backgrounds, religions, beliefs or lack of religion or belief.

The School does not tolerate any form of discrimination and is committed to ensuring equality of opportunity in line with the Equality Act 2010.

Principle of secularism ('laïcité')

The School teaches the French curriculum and thus applies the principle of laïcité in its curriculum. This means that there is no religious education. However, the subject of religion can be studied, for example in various civilisations throughout history as well as modern religions.

Worship policy

Collective worship of any religious beliefs is not practised at the School and there are no religious daily assemblies.

Special provisions

Special provisions can be agreed with the Headteacher for pupils, for e.g. with particular religious dietary needs.
